

MUSIC COLLECTION FOR SALE

KOPN, a community radio station founded in 1973, is moving to a smaller home. It needs to reduce its extensive music library by half. Volunteers are currently reviewing the collection to determine what music will move to the new location. What cannot go will be sold.

We are seeking proposals for the purchase of this collection.

Description of collection:

- It is estimated that there will be a minimum of 10,000 vinyl records for sale.
- The major genres are: Contemporary Folk, Bluegrass, Jazz, Blues, Country, Rock and Soul
- The vinyl records are generally in excellent condition; the covers are badly worn. The vinyl records and their covers are all marked with KOPN in black marker (i.e., Sharpie)

KOPN will accept offers to purchase this collection as follows:

- Delivery will be at a location of seller's choosing in Columbia, Missouri
- The sale will be without warranty of any kind
- KOPN reserves the right to reject any and all offers
- The sale will be "buyer takes all"
- Offers to purchase may be made for the entire collection, or by major genre. KOPN plans to accept the offer that will be of greatest benefit to the station and its owner New Wave Corporation. Offers on individual genres may be combined to determine the best offer
- Those individuals, organizations or companies interested in making an offer may view the collection at the station's location in Columbia, Missouri, upon arrangement with station staff
- An index of the major genres is available upon request. As the process for determining which records will go with the station to its new home, these indexes will be revised to reflect the LPs being retained by the station, and those that will be part of the sale. The accuracy of these indexes is not guaranteed
- All offers must be accompanied by a cash bond in the amount of 10% of the offer. This bond will be returned if the offer is not accepted.
- Offers must be received at the station's location at 915 East Broadway, Columbia, Missouri no later than June 7. The collection of records for sale will be available for inspection beginning on May 15
- Offers will be accepted from not-for-profit entities to receive donation of the collection, or major genres thereof. Offers to accept donation should include information on the not-for-profit organization and how acceptance of the music collection is within its stated mission
